

Simple How-to guide for Office Weekly 50/50 Raffle Drawings:



This fundraiser is one of the very *easiest* ways your business can raise significant funds to help kids in your area battling cancer find healing in the outdoors. With only 100 tickets purchased each week, you can raise up to \$15,000 a year!

- 1) Materials needed: 2 cash bags, a container to put tickets into for the drawing, and few rolls of double tickets. Double tickets are available at local party stores or online. One cash bag will be used for making change, and the other will go in the safe for donations.
- 2) Choose the day and time you want to do your drawing each week. Every Friday seems to work great!
- 3) Using the poster design template provided on the “FUN-Raising Toolkit” at www.carecamps.org, customize and print out posters to utilize around your office with the day and time for the drawing.
- 4) Utilizing the “Volunteer Sign Up Form” provided, ask your team sign up to sell tickets each week at your location. It’s a fun and easy way to get your team involved and takes very little time! You can also reach out to local sports leagues, concerts, or other events and ask if you can sell 50/50 tickets at their events for Care Camps.
- 5) Use the “What is Care Camps” info sheet provided to educate your team, especially those who are selling the tickets, so they can answer questions! You can email Jennifer below with any questions. Keep a copy of the “What is Care Camps” sheet laminated with your bucket/tickets for easy reference.
- 6) Sell tickets for \$5 for a single ticket or \$20 for 5 tickets.
- 7) Once sold, the purchaser keeps their half of the tickets and the office keeps the matching 2nd half to put in the drawing bucket. (Having them fill out their names makes it much easier to identify the winner!)
- 8) Each week, after selling tickets, have someone pick the winning ticket at the designated day and time and post the winning name or number by the time clock or in the break room.
- 9) Extra ways to have fun: take a picture of your winner with their cash each week and send in for Dometic and Care Camps newsletters and social media posts.
- 10) Count the ticket sales: $\frac{1}{2}$ of the money collected goes to the winner and the other $\frac{1}{2}$ of the money goes to Care Camps to help area kids. Tape this on the bottom of your bucket so you never have to look up the address for sending donations!

On the last day of each month, help your team celebrate your success by marking your donations on the Care Camps donations thermometer, and send in your donations to:
