## **Weekly Office or Community Care Camps BINGO Game:**

**Doing an Bingo game for your team every week is a cheap, fun and easy teambuilder;  
it is also a great way to get your community involved and aware of your business!**

1. Purchase Bingo cards, numbers, and a spinner from a local party store or online. If you laminate the bingo cards they can last for months! Choose the day of the week, time, and location for your game.
2. Decide whether you want to do this as a weekly office teambuilder or something for the community. If you choose to do a community Bingo game, reach out to local service clubs, youth groups, etc and ask them to partner with you and supply the volunteers! (Volunteer request letter and Volunteer sign up sheet available on the Care Camps FUN-Raising Kit online.)
3. Using the customizable templates for posters/flyers available on the Care Camps Fundraising Toolkit, hang up posters around the office or your community saying the day and time for BINGO. If doing a community bingo game, create an event on Facebook and have your team invite all their friends! You can also send out a press release to the media to generate interest.
4. Have staff or volunteers sell bingo cards at the door. You can determine the price based on your audience. One sample idea: 1 card for \$5, 2 cards for \$7, 3 cards for \$9, or 4 for \$10! You can increase your revenue substantially by selling "concessions". Beverages, popcorn, snacks, etc.
5. Using the "What is Care Camps" info sheet from the FUN-Raising toolkit, educate the volunteers/staff who are selling Bingo cards what Care Camps is about so they can tell your guests. Keep the info sheet with your Bingo cards for easy reference. Start the game off by playing the Care Camps video, or simply explain what Care Camps is. You can also make copies of the info sheet for the tables.
6. For the different Bingo games, you can find 100 different ideas online, but the last game is always the "Grand Prize", where half of the total goes to Care Camps, and the other half goes to the winner.
7. Leading up to the "Grand Prize" game you can play different kinds of bingo games, giving away little gifts after each one. Some examples of prizes: Candy bars, donated items from the community, a ticket for a free ice cream bar, or just go to dollar store and pick up some cute giveaways.
8. Some examples of different types of games: first one to get the letter T, the letter X, all the top row and bottom row, straight line, the list goes on and on. You can find many more creative ideas online! The Grand Prize game is filling up the entire card. If you have a tie, the players split the winner's half and Care Camps gets the 2<sup>nd</sup> half. Many people will donate back because they are just there to have fun!
